QPWS manages Daisy Hill Conservation Park well for recreation and many people visit from all over the region. On Saturday and Sunday mornings, the top dirt car park before the entrance is full of runners, dog walkers, horse riders and mountain bikers.

The MTB tracks Tunnel of Love, Possum Box and Wil's Run are MTB only trails. QPWS rangers are continuing to work with local clubs and independent riders to manage MTB use of these trails.

Logan City Council Parks
 The 4km multiuse trail through the bushland at Underwood Park provides a good mix of trail experiences for the beginner. Venture further into Neville Lawrie Reserve for a longer ride using wide roads and single tracks. The famous MTB track, Nirvana is situated in Kimberley Forest Reserve, usually accessed through Daisy Hill Forest.

Redland Shire Council manages the area containing Stonehenge MTB track. As more trail care sessions are conducted, more single track will be sanctioned.
